It's Christmas, this year there is certainly a sense of relief that we have made it to the end of the year!

To mark this tragedy and pay our respects there will be a small procession by our town guides from the Royal Hotel to the maids' monument in St Marys churchyard where flowers will be laid and a few prayers said.

Charity Plea

This year has been a difficult one for everyone, but particularly for charities. A group of people based in St Patrick's Church, Endmoor, and other local churches, sponsor children in the Good Samaritan Orphanage, Andhra Pradesh, South India, which is run by Christians. These children have been born into families who are extremely poor and cannot support them or have lost their parents to HIV or other terminal illnesses. Just like here, parents of children had lost their jobs, but there is no welfare state. To keep their children alive, they had to take them to the Orphanage.

Footpaths and rights of way



Over the past few months, I've written a few articles with recommended walks in and around Kirkby Lonsdale, and with increasing numbers of locals and visitors enjoying walking during this year's lockdowns, I thought I would write a piece about footpaths and rights of way in the local area.

When the Yorkshire Dales National Park was extended in 2016 to cover much of the Kirkby Lonsdale area, Cumbria County Council delegated the National Park Authority with responsibility for most aspects of managing the public rights of way. This includes maintenance of the path surface, foot- and bridle- bridges and signposts, and assisting landowners with maintaining gates and stiles. So it was the YDNPA, with co-operation of the Underley Estate, that surfaced the footpath between Lily Wood and the Underley business centre. Many of us are already appreciating not sliding around in the mud! Work is ongoing with the wooden bridge in the wood, as a main beam has cracked, so the path is closed. There are plans afoot to replace the bridge and install some steps down the slope.

It is Cumbria County Council Highways who maintain concrete and tarmac paths within urban areas, so they look after parts of the riverside path, and it was they who filled and faced with concrete a void under the bottom of the Radical Steps. The work to repair the river bank (the section with a fence temporarily erected) will involve the Town Council as landowner, as it is their section of the bank that has washed away.

We should never take our footpaths for granted: there are estimated to be over 150,000 miles of them in the country, but not all footpaths are rights of way, such as the permissive path through the rugby club grounds. And there is no right of way onto land not accessed by a public footpath, even if it contains a heritage site, for instance Casterton Stone Circle, which can actually be most clearly identified from the footpath.

REMEMBERING FIVE MAIDS 'HASTENED TO ETERNITY'

Sunday 6th December 2020 marks the 200th anniversary of a catastrophic fire that destroyed 'one of the most noted inns in Westmorland' and 'hastened five maids into eternity'.

The Rose and Crown was situated next to a private home called Jackson Hall, which we know today as *The Royal Hotel*. It overlooked Jackson Hall's gardens which were later to become the town's Market Square. After the fire, a 'New Road' was driven through the rubble of the burnt-out building, and the name stuck.

The inn must have been so well-known that the fire was documented in *The Annual Register, Or, A View of the History, Politics, and Literature of the year 1820*, a reference book that has been recording important international events since 1758. In January it recorded the death of King George III, and in December:

FIRE at KIRBY LONSDALE. The family at the Rose and Crown on the night of the fire consisted of Mrs. Roper, her two daughters, Mr. Preston, six servant men, five servant maids, and a girl who had formerly been a servant in the house, and who was lodging on that night at the inn. The family retired to rest about midnight; and Mrs. Roper, after looking over the premises to see that all was safe, retired to her own room. Soon after 1 o'clock, on Thursday morning, she was alarmed by the smell of fire. By the most extraordinary exertions, the daughters of Mrs. Roper and the six male servants succeeded in effecting their escape; but the flames had spread with such fatal rapidity, that it is probable the remaining five girls were not aware of their danger till all hope of escape was extinguished: they all sunk into the jaws of death without any attempt having been made to save them. The instant Mrs. Roper found herself in the street, she ran through the town in the state in which she had risen from her bed to alarm the inhabitants, and to obtain their assistance. In a very short time a number of people were collected; and not suspecting that any persons were still in the house, their exertions were solely directed to preserving the adjoining buildings, and rescuing such part of the stock and furniture as they were able to save.

The story is also recorded in "The Annals of Kirkby Lonsdale":

On the 6th December, 1820, about one o'clock in the morning the proprietress of the inn was awakened by the crackling of flames and a suffocating smoke and soon saw that the whole house would very shortly be ablaze. She hurriedly aroused her daughter and all the servants she could manage to get to, but she was forced to fly for her life when her clothing and hair began to singe. Rushing with her daughter first to one and then to the other staircase, they found both a mass of flames, but just managed to escape and save their lives by leaping through a window. The alarm quickly spread to all the occupants of the house. Six men servants who slept in one room wrenched out the iron window stanchions and just got out in time, but five of the maid servants perished. The whole town was soon aroused and people rushed about in terror, each asking the other what to do, while many risked their lives in making the most heroic attempts at rescues. The flames were soon beyond the power of any one to extinguish, so the inn was entirely demolished. An extremely impressive funeral service was held for the five maids, and an obelisk in the churchyard by the Vicarage footpath, suitably inscribed, gives a record of their death and their burial. The fire was caused by a red hot cinder which had lodged in a brush used by a servant to sweep up a hearth, which, after being placed under the staircase, had taken fire, setting the stairs alight and ultimately the whole of the house.

Next time you walk through St Mary's churchyard, pause by the obelisk that the people of the town had erected in memory of Agnes Nicholson, Hannah Armstrong, Bella Cornthwaite, Agnes Waller, and Alice Clarke.

We won't be able to offer our full volunteer service on those days but we will be able to help if you have an emergency and aren't sure where to find help, or if you just want to have a friendly chat.

The Community Cupboard

The Community Cupboard has been operating since May, initially out of QES Lunesdale Sports Centre then, since September, at the Rugby Club. From its first week of deliveries at the start of lockdown The Cupboard has been held up by cheerful volunteers and a wider support network to call upon for advice and guidance.

We have been funded locally by generous residents, local groups and by Cumbria County initiatives and feel confident that we can meet demand in whatever form it presents itself. The Community Cupboard has been created to head off any crisis situations and provide greater options for those living with existing or new challenges on their budgets. We hope that it will become a part of the glue that holds the community together.

One enormous movement that has come from setting up The Community Cupboard is our Food Club. The Food Club operates on a weekly basis, collecting food from Preston's Fareshare depot and sharing it out amongst our 72 members. This food is basically nearing its sell-by date or costing supermarkets too much to keep on warehouse shelves. It frees up money to enable local treats, after-school activities and uniforms as well as reducing landfill. A large share goes into the weekly parcels in the Community Cupboard. Anyone can join and everyone can benefit.

So, can we make a real effort to rethink what The Community Cupboard is and can become? Spread the word, talk about it positively and suggest friends who are going through shaky times dip in and see if it helps or refer elderly households who would benefit from a weekly/biweekly parcel.

Access to Community Cupboard is via klcommunity.co.uk or by calling The Community Hub on 015242 36404. There are no barriers to you accessing this provision and the ability to repay the help received is there at any time through volunteering time or donations when the time is right. Should you wish to access support anonymously, please be reassured that confidentiality will be respected.

KL Food Club is also accessed through klcommunity.co.uk, click on Food Club link and register your interest, the club is currently full but is operating a waiting list to which you will be added.

Thank you to the Masonic Charitable Foundation and the Provincial Grand Lodge of Cumberland and Westmorland Freemasons, for generously supporting the Community Cupboard with funding that it is a part of the support they have given to four Food Banks in the area.


