



If we're feeling the pressures of life, or when things don't go according to plan it's easy to imagine that everyone else is doing fine when actually you don't have to scratch far beneath the surface to learn that behind the cheery smile is a huge bag of worries!

I regularly go into primary schools to lead assemblies, and sometimes I have used a book called `The Huge bag of worries', by Virginia Ironside. The story is about a little girl called Jenny who was worried about lots of things. Eventually she wakes one morning to find a huge bag of worries, which follows her everywhere. The more she worries the larger the worrisome bag gets; `it was like a horrible shadow she couldn't get rid of'.

Finally, a kindly older neighbour spots the bag and the lady suggests they have a look inside the bag together. Jenny is obviously nervous, but the lady says, 'There's nothing a worry hates more than being seen...the secret is to let them out slowly one by one and show them to someone else, they'll soon go away'. The story goes on to say Jenny was astonished how small the worries looked when they were out in the open: 'half the worries disappeared because lots of worries hate the light of day; some she sent packing because they belonged to other people; and some were worries everybody had'!

It feels like there is currently so much to worry about, as individuals, community, society and globally. There seems to be such a lot to contend with!

During our Lent course this year we have been exploring the issue of failure. Living with the effects of all kinds of failure causes us anxiety. We discussed the broad effects of sin and failure on ourselves, others, and society. The material highlighted historic failures, and also the unjust societal systems we are all a part of. We have considered the fact that generally society is obsessed with success, and in the world's eyes, those who fail are unworthy of love and acceptance. We have acknowledged that we all fail; that failure is universal. However, we have also been encouraged to see failure as an opportunity for learning and growth. Sometimes failure is necessary to progress, taking risks and allowing for the possibility of failure rather than being fearful, and resisting change. We approached the answer to failure through the biblical principles of forgiveness, reconciliation, and restoration.

Really that is what Easter is all about, The Cross is itself a symbol of failure, abandonment, and shame, but it is where God, in some amazing way, takes the failures and mistakes upon himself – and offers, in exchange, life in all its fullness, a new beginning. We fail, but that doesn't mean we are 'a failure'. No-one is beyond redemption: 'For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life', (John 3:16).

So instead of worry, we are offered hope, as in Jesus own words 'Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life.....but seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.' I wish you Easter Hope and Joy.

Kirkby Lonsdale Town Council

After our April meeting all councillors stand down and nominations are invited from anyone who would like to be a councillor for the next four years. You must live within the town, or within three miles of a boundary of the town. We have nine councillors and if there are more than nine nominations an election will be held on 4 May.

Why be a Town Councillor?....a very good question!

This is why I am a town councillor (and would like to remain one). I joined the Council as I felt I could make a difference and because there were a number of issues I wanted to get involved in. I believe we now have a Council which is proactive rather than reactive, has a well-developed work programme and has a better gender and age balance. We have some very difficult issues to deal with, including: funding and resources; the Brow/Ruskin's View; a new local government structure; and opportunities for further delegation of functions to the Council. There is an overriding need for the Town Council (TC), the Community Interest Company (CIC) and the Chamber of Trade (CoT) to work together to develop a shared strategy for growing the town economically and protecting those elements which we hold dear.

Kirkby has a wealth of talent and people with the right skills to help drive the Town forward, why not become a councillor and help us? Nominations close on 4 April, but there will have been notices around the town well before you read this.

One councillor of long standing and age (sorry Allan) is Allan Muirhead and he has announced that he will not be standing again. Allan has been a councillor for over 20 years. He was Chairman from 2011 to 2016 and Deputy Chairman from 2019-2023. Alan was instrumental in establishing the Community Interest Company and forging strong relationships with the District and County Councils. However, as an ex-journalist, he is perhaps best known as being 'the voice of the town'. The town owes him a huge debt of gratitude and we all wish him, Liz and the family all the best for the future. However, I fear we may not have heard the last from him on Town Council matters!!

We are close to resolving one important issue for the town. If you search online for Kirkby Lonsdale you come up with three main sites – the CIC, CoT and TC sites. None of the sites are as up to date as they should be and create confusion. All three organisations agree that there should be one web site for the town and discussions are taking place to ensure that there is a new high quality web site which 'sells' the town.

We have had two Town Council meetings since the last AKL...we agreed a new two-year town maintenance contract with Craig Bradshaw, were updated on the Ram sculpture and improvements to the Play Park and agreed £1,000 towards the Coronation celebrations.

Leave peat where it belongs!

94% of our UK peatlands are in a decimated state, an environmental catastrophe resulting from more than 70 years of inappropriate farming policy and ongoing commercial extraction for the amateur and professional horticulture sector.

The encouraging news is that peat for the amateur gardening sector will be banned in England from 2024 with several retailers already selling good quality, peatfree composts. Yet, concerningly, there is no date when peat use in the professional sector will be banned. The RHS has pledged that all its gardens, show displays and plant sales will be peat free by 2025 (its bagged compost already is), yet your consumer pressure is needed to encourage other show gardens and garden centres to do the right thing and follow suit.

Top tips for going peat free this April:

Visit: www.wildlifetrusts.org/actions/how-go-peat-free for a list of which retailers are – and aren't – peat free!

Check labels on potted plants, pellets, plugs and composts and only buy those that state they are peat free. 'Environmentally friendly' does not mean peat free.

Stand up for peatlands: If they don't stock what you want in a peat-free option – ask for it and explain why.

Experiment with ways of improving your soils naturally and organically. www.gardenorganic and www.rhs.org.uk have guidance for creating healthy soils. They also have information about how to develop your own compost, one of the most environmentally friendly ways to go peat free.

It is good to have started holding meetings regularly again at The Highwayman in Burrow (as we did before the Covid pandemic) where Club members can enjoy a drink, a meal and catch-up with fellow Rotarians.

I can report once again that we have enjoyed some really good talks in the past month. Ron Nelson gave an excellent talk about the Barrow-in-Furness shipyard. Some of the most notable vessels built there include the Royal Navy flagship HMS Albion and the former flagships HMS Bulwark and HMS Invincible sometimes referred to as the Pride of Barrow.

Species-rich meadows are not only more resistant to climate change and store more carbon than non-biodiverse grasslands, but also support plants, insect life and bird species.

The principles of nature positive verge management are simple:

Cut verges or other village grassland no later than April and clear cuttings away to prevent the build-up of thatch, which increases soil nitrogen levels and can encourage docks, nettles and thistles to take hold.

Do not cut the grass between May and August (inclusive) to allow plants to flower and set seed.

If cutting can't be avoided, consider mowing paths or narrow edge strips but leave some areas uncut as a wildlife refuge. This can also help to address concerns about untidiness and safety.

Remove invasive weeds (nettles, thistles, docks) by chopping down/uprooting, not spraying.

Do a second cut in September – clearing all cuttings.

In other words, Cut Less, Cut Later, Takeaway!




