



Suddenly, everything was green and hope-filled, for in the words of the Coronation Song – 'Brighter Days are Coming'. At least, shorter days and warmer days!

It has felt as though we were spending an inordinate amount of time just waiting – for spring, for better weather, for the Coronation, for Brighter Days. I wonder how it felt for our new King – he waited for decades to be king, but for that to happen it meant the death of his beloved mother. Yet he used all those years in many positive, constructive ways for the good of all sorts of people and to grow as a person.

It struck me that we can get a bit lost in what feels like endless waiting. All the time we get stuck in looking to tomorrow, next week, month, year or when 'I have the time', or can afford it, or when whatever it is changes. In all that time we're stuck and we miss everything that's happening NOW. Living in the present moment, noticing something about the right now that is uplifting and encouraging, can make a huge difference to our mood and outlook – I've just looked up from my desk and seen the swifts are back (or they might be house martins) sweeping and swirling overhead – a sure sign of summer. I could so easily have missed the moment!

Thinking about remaining in the present moment, I recall some of the words the Bible says about waiting -

"Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!"
Psalm 27:14

Waiting for God to act can feel more difficult than waiting for the change in the weather. We can be sure that spring will follow winter, and summer spring, but we can often wonder if God is still there. Does he know what's going on? Why doesn't he act? And yet the verse goes on to say 'be strong, take courage'; maybe in that conscious act of deliberate waiting for God, our courage and strength grow. But, I hear you say, what can we do in these waiting times, which seem so frustrating and a waste of time.

Well, I'm reminded of another Bible verse that might help:

"Be still, and know that I am God!" Psalm 46:10

I am convinced that being still, taking time out, just being quiet and reflective, really does help settle the frustration of waiting. Stopping our endless round of 'what-ifs', and 'whys' and just dwelling in the present moment. Noticing something small, or big, that we wouldn't otherwise have seen, can change our whole perspective. And, as we pause, we might think to ourselves 'this is just the way things are at the present moment'. We pay attention deliberately and non-judgementally to the way things are right now. And we give ourselves space. Space to take a deep breath and maybe in that moment of stillness we know more deeply the presence of God and his care.

I hope by the time this magazine is published we have arrived in summer and we will all enjoy every moment.



#### **Kirkby Lonsdale Town Council**

At the Annual Town Assembly meeting the Chair has to report on the year's activities. An abridged version of my report on 17 May follows.

'It has been a challenging and rewarding time for the town and the Town Council.

Whilst the technical and cost issues associated with reopening the Brow footpath and 'Saving Ruskin's View' have perhaps been the main topics considered by the Town Council, there have been many other issues that have brought the town closer together.

Many organisations joined together in what has become the 'Community Share' to make the Christmas celebrations in 2022 such a success and in arranging events around the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations, the passing of Queen Elizabeth II and the coronation of Charles III. Whilst the town is a major tourist destination, many of these events were locally focussed and brought residents together.

The Town Council has supported local initiatives as much as possible and in particular has part funded the Community Interest Company (CIC), given grants to a number of local organisations and both last year and in the coming year has provided significant financial support to the Community Cupboard, an initiative born of the pandemic but recognising the long-standing needs of our community.

In the coming year the Council has committed funds to improving access to the Play Park and carrying out improvements to the park itself; relet the grounds maintenance contract which should result in the town parks and open spaces being maintained to the high standard

#### **B4RN for Kirkby Lonsdale**

We are writing to provide a short update on our plans for the B4RN project in Kirkby Lonsdale.

We have successfully completed Phase 1 of the build together, and there are currently 156 properties live on this part of the network. We really couldn't have achieved this without the support of the local community – thank you.

This work was always planned to be the first phase of a project that would connect all of Kirkby Lonsdale. This is still the ambition, but there is another supplier who has also announced build plans to connect towns and villages in the region, and so this ambition is currently on hold.

This announcement has presented us with two issues. Firstly, we don't want to be in a position where we are duplicating building a full fibre network. Secondly, our build is reliant on government funding through the voucher scheme, and this funding only remains available

achieved over recent years; and we may even get a large metal ram on the A65/Booths roundabout.

Deciding on the final work programme to re-open the Brow footpath and raising the funds to do this are the biggest issues facing the Council. In the next month it is expected that a final programme of works and the likely costs will be identified by the Council's engineering consultants, Fairhurst. A further public meeting will be arranged to update residents.

The Town Council has employed a specialist to develop and implement a funding strategy and a fundraising coordinator. Both have been instrumental in establishing a 'Friends of Ruskin's View' group and in turn that group has helped implement the strategy and organise a wide variety of fundraising events, all of which have been given wide media coverage.

The Town Council will continue to lead on this campaign and to date the support from the town and local area has been amazing. Whist we have a long way to go, I am confident that we will achieve the re-opening of the footpath, when, I am not sure.'

#### **Co-option to the Town Council**

There is one vacancy on the Town Council and we can now appoint by co-option rather than by election. 

We were totally honoured to be contacted by Phoebe, with a request to create something flowery for the town's street party celebrations to mark his Majesty's coronation, what an occasion. For us, everything looks and feels better with fresh flowers, so of course it was a huge YES!

We were aware that we wanted it to be something super special on several levels, we wanted something that looked beautiful, striking, and impactful enough, whilst also wanting it to be symbolic of the occasion. We were keen to include scent, and importantly we hoped it could span generations and be current. We hoped also to be as environmentally conscious as possible, especially given the King's ideas and values regarding sustainability in the floristry.

We decided to create something inside the monument, so whatever the weather our flowers could still be enjoyed – a photo booth, where people could sit and

capture gorgeous memories of the day, surrounded by beautiful blooms.

For our immediate inspiration we looked to the official Coronation invitation. We wanted to echo the beauty of the colours and flowers used, so as far as the aesthetic for the installation was an English country garden with a mix of native, woodland foliage's.

We wanted as much of our installation as possible to be locally sourced, so our first stop was our gardens; cow parsley, blossoms, bluebells and foliage of beech, birch, hazel, and oak. Herbs of rosemary, both for scent and in remembrance of the late Queen, sage, bay, and the eucalyptus we used were also all home grown.

Representing the nations of Great Britain was another priority high on our list, with the tall green spires of Molucella (Bells of Ireland). The spikey blue spheres of Eryngium (blue thistles). Both white and red roses for England, and the ancient royal houses of Lancaster and York, (both had to be included as I'm a Yorkshire girl and we're on the border!) The yellow of Wales came from yellow ranunculus, a gorgeous spring flower, as all our narcissi and daffodils were finished.

The other flower choices all common in English country gardens, deep blue clematis, tall white gladioli, delicate scabious, nigella, and wonderfully scented stocks.

Centre stage of the photo booth was the most beautifully regal oak chair. We were very kindly given permission from Rev Snow, to use one of the Bishop's chairs from St Mary's church, intricately carved with crowns, and so it became a throne for the day, echoes of Edward the Confessor's chair in Westminster Abbey, although not quite so old!

We had so much fun on Sunday morning placing and finishing off the flowers in the square, it was a hive of activity from around 8am with Market traders, volunteers and the great and the good of Kirkby Lonsdale all hoping to mark the occasion and make a really special day for all, I was so excited to show my children the installation when they arrived, my 9 year old's response: 'hmmm they are OK, when are the alpacas arriving!'





"I've just had my bathroom retiled, but I'm not happy with the work. The tradesperson left to do another job halfway through and I had to chase them to finish the job. The work looks pretty rough

around the edges. They also left all the old tiles and plaster for me to dispose of, which I wasn't expecting. I've now got the invoice, but I don't think the price reflects the work done or the service I got. Can I challenge this?"

If the work looks unfinished or unsafe, you should be able to get the tiler to come back to fix it. You could also suggest that removing the old tiles is part of finishing the job. You are protected by the Consumer Rights Act 2015, which says a tradesperson should have completed the work with 'reasonable care and skill'. If they haven't done this, they've broken the law. The Act means you're legally entitled to ask the tiler to fix the problem (if they provided the tiles as well as the service) or get money refunded (if they just provided the service and you bought the tiles). They should fix the problem or refund you in a reasonable amount of time, without causing too much inconvenience. Ask them to fix the issue or negotiate a lower price for the work before you pay anything.

Before you contact them, it's a good idea to take photographs to use as evidence of the problem. Make notes about what happened, including dates and times. You should also gather any paperwork and receipts - was there any prior written agreement about who would dispose of the old tiles? Was the final cost was in line with estimates or quotes given to you at the outset of the work? If not, there is advice on the Citizens Advice website.

Let the tiler know you understand what you're entitled to. Keep a written copy of all contacts, whether you speak to them, write or email. There are template letters on the Citizens Advice website. If you're still struggling to come to an agreement, there are other steps you can take, including using 'alternative dispute resolution', which is a way of solving disagreements without going to court. There are full details about how to do this on the Citizens Advice website.


