



The days are lengthening and the signs of spring are appearing. It is a remarkable time of year when we can watch the world around us being transformed. Centuries ago, when people were talking about this time of year, they would use the term 'lencten', (it means 'spring season'). That word has disappeared from use but somewhere along the line a shortened form, Lent, became the title for the weeks leading up to the festival of Easter.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which was 22 February this year. It lasts for 40 days, (a little bit of mathematics will tell you whether Sundays are included or excluded in the 40 days of Lent). In the year 325 an assembly of religious delegates, known as the Council of Nicaea, decreed that Easter should be observed on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the spring equinox (21 March). This means that Easter Day can fall on any Sunday between 22 March and 25 April.

Consequently, the start of Lent moves each year according to the date of Easter, although it is always a Wednesday.

People often associate Lent with 'giving things up'. It is a tradition that derives from the connection between the season of Lent and the period of forty days that Jesus spent in the wilderness before the start of his public ministry. He was hungry and he was tempted. For some people, fasting during Lent helps them remember what it is like for the great many people in the world who do not have enough food.

Some people collect money in a 'Grace jar' during Lent; adding a coin before each meal as a way of saying 'thank you' for having enough to eat, and then donating the contents when Easter arrives. I wonder what will happen to traditions like this as we become an increasingly cashless society?

'Taking something up' can be just as good as giving something up. Simply taking time to observe the world around us and notice things coming back to life as the days lengthen after the dark days of winter can be incredibly therapeutic. Something that can work very well in a family setting is to jointly come up with forty 'Lenten deeds': something to do on each day of the season. The idea is that these are simple things that someone can do to support and encourage the other members of the family or the wider community. Taking it in turns, one person performs the deed for the day.

A few years ago, I came across a Lenten prayer that rather cleverly combines 'giving up' and 'taking up'. It offers a holistic approach to Lent and it goes like this:

Help us fast from criticism
and feast on the good we see in others.
Help us fast from inactivity
and feast on action for justice.
Help us fast from greed
and feast on giving.
Help us fast from conflict
and feast on peace making.
Help us from self-centredness
and feast on Christ-likeness
so that we might become more like your Son.

I also like the way that the 'us' in the prayer could refer to a family or a community, or even the whole of humanity. In these challenging times the prayer is hopeful that somehow by the end of Lent both we, and situations, might be transformed.

#### Actions speak louder than words

As part of my role as the Family Project Leader, I have the privilege of visiting three different primary schools. I love learning alongside children and I find assemblies are often the place where that happens naturally. This last month I have taken various assemblies, but one that stood out was one school visit where we gathered to think about the parable of the two sons. The story goes that a farmer wanted to pick his fruit from his vineyard. He asked the first son to help him, but he said no. However, once his father had gone, he thought about it again and decided to go and help him.

Meanwhile, his father had gone to see his second son and asked him to help him pick the fruit. The second son agreed to help, but he never showed up to help. When I asked the children which son did the right thing, everyone agreed it was the first son. We then thought about why he may have initially said no. We had some fantastic We had a go at juggling and learnt that Dr Kaye had this answers including, 'he woke up moody', perhaps 'he was tired or hungry' or even 'he felt lazy'. We imagined how much self-control or even self-talk the son may have had to move from deciding to stay at home to deciding to get up, leave the house and join his father in picking the fruit. To move from a position of thinking about himself to thinking about his dad.

Next, we considered the words a famous Catholic Friar, Francis of Assisi, who spoke about showing God's love to the world primarily by action rather than merely talking about it. He said 'Preach the Gospel at all times. Use

words if necessary.' We wondered what this might mean for them today and how we could show God's love through actions. Answers included 'smile at people', 'do a job before you are asked', 'share what you have, including food' and 'be kind'. Wise words. I think this is something we are all able to do, but it can be hard, particularly if you 'wake up moody.' I hope this month you can receive God's love via others' selflessness and kindness. Look out for those extra smiles!

One place where we saw a few big smiles was at our last Muddy Church. Although we were small in number, the company and chance to chat together was really valued by all who came. We spent time thinking about hidden things in nature before thinking a little bit about the Easter story. We remembered how Jesus, after he had been on the cross, was put hidden away in a cave. But then he rose again!

hidden talent! We ended by planting some sunflowers. During the pandemic, sunflowers became a symbol of hope for many, their bright yellow bringing light onto days that felt at times very dark. I still find it astonishing how such a bright big flower began its life in a very small seed that is then hidden in the ground.

Our next Messy Church is on Sunday 19 March at Kirkby Lonsdale Methodist Church from 4.30-6pm. Our theme is Caring for others! Do come along. As always there will be various activities, some storytelling and yummy food. All welcome. Lol



#### **Kirkby Lonsdale Town Council**

We decided to rearrange the date of the February Town Council meeting as it clashed with an important online discussion between Parish and Town Councils and the new Westmorland and Furness Council (WFC). I will report on the February Town Council meeting next month.

The 'Teams' (ie online) discussion with the locality team from WFC was interesting and thought provoking, with many Parish and Town Councils facing the same issues we have of limited resources and a shortage of relevant skills. Good points were made such as the need for residents to be able to log on to Council meetings rather than attending in person. The disappointing aspect was to be told that any further devolution of powers/responsibilities was likely to be some years off.

The new authority has announced how it is going to be dealing with planning applications. As it is a much bigger authority than SLDC, it is setting up a strategic Planning Committee to deal with matters such as major infrastructure projects and mineral workings. All other planning applications will either be dealt with at officer level or by a Local Area Planning Committee – there will be three Area Committees based on the boundaries of the current Barrow, Eden, and South Lakeland Councils. In effect this means no change for us!! However, the recent performance of SLDC in dealing with planning applications has been very poor and in discussions with officers and members of the new authority we have stressed the need for significant improvement.

The Save Ruskin's View fundraising efforts are resulting in some significant donations including an individual donation of £5,000 and a pledge of £30,000 from a local firm. A number of events are planned for the first part of this year and they will appear elsewhere in AKL. There is a long way to go, but the level of community support is not only appreciated, but vital. One of the key points will be the likely costs of the works – two contractors have visited the site and by the end of February we are likely to have cost estimates. Once these have been considered by the Council the task ahead of us should be clearer.

As I was changing the locks on the gate the other day a young woman walked along the path towards me. I asked how she got onto the path, she said she climbed over the railings. I asked if she had seen the gates and the warning notices, she said 'no'. Barely credible!! Our technical consultants are of the view that the path is breaking up further and that in particular the second viewing area is highly dangerous — they will not go on it. Please don't access the footpath and if you see anybody trying to do this, please warn them of the risks.

More on this next month, but in April all Town Councillors stand down and anyone can put their names forward for the new Council. We face challenging times and it would be great if there was strong interest in joining the Council.

In the first session, we will concentrate on Georgian architecture. Classical designs from the Mediterranean came to England via Palladio and Inigo Jones and became the norm in the 18th century. They proved adaptable and convenient throughout the Empire and in the newly independent United States. The second session looks at the Victorian period when buildings were confident and exuberant architectural historians use the word 'eclectic' which can be summed up as 'anything goes'.

The cost for the two afternoons is £20 for members, £25 for non-members, and for one afternoon £15.







"Life is getting more and more expensive. I've seen offers for 'Buy Now Pay Later' when I'm doing online shopping. It seems like a good way to spread the cost of some of the things I need to get for my family but how can I make sure I don't get into debt?"

There are lots of things you can do to try and stay in control of your money, but you are right to be wary of 'Buy Now Pay Later' offers. Before you start spending, work out exactly what money you have coming in and going out each month. Be realistic about what you need for essentials like food and travel. Take a look at the <a href="budgeting tool">budgeting tool</a> on the Citizens Advice website. This can help you set a budget you can stick to. You'll also be able to find tips on <a href="how to reduce your regular living costs">how to reduce your regular living costs</a>.

While it can be tempting to split payments with schemes like Buy Now Pay Later (BNPL), you will need to pay in the end, so you need to plan how you will do it. Keep a record of how much you owe in total.

Always make sure you understand what you're signing up for, how you'll make the repayments and what will happen if you can't pay on time. It's important to check the returns process for both the retailer and credit provider. Paying through BNPL may also affect the cost of postage returns if you've ordered online. The riskiest thing about it is that you're not guaranteed to be protected if something goes wrong. For example, you can't go to the Financial Ombudsman Service if you have a complaint.

If you find yourself turning to credit cards, your overdraft, or store cards for your spending, keep track of what you owe. You should prioritise paying your rent or mortgage, plus energy bills and Council Tax first, because not paying these has the most serious consequences. On the <u>Citizens Advice website</u>, you can find information on what bills to prioritise and how to manage debts. There's also information on <u>the support available for paying these and other bills</u>.


