

Let me depress you all by talking about Christmas 2023!

It was generally agreed that last year's Christmas Fair was the most successful yet. The event was coordinated by Phoebe Rodway, who was employed by the Community Interest Company (CIC) in conjunction with a large range of organisations across the town, given the umbrella name of the Community Share. Phoebe has left the CIC, although she is coming back on a short-term basis to help organise the Coronation weekend.

The CIC is facing considerable financial pressures and as a result cannot afford to employ a replacement for Phoebe. Without someone leading on the Christmas Fair it would either not take place or it would be a poor imitation of last year's event. This issue has been debated at Community Share meetings and a short-term solution now appears possible.

The CIC has drawn up a job description for a part-time post of Event Leader operating between June and December and it is estimated that the cost of the contract would be circa £5,000. No one organisation can afford to fund this post, but the Town Council has agreed to fund 50% of the cost (i.e., £2,500). On the assumption that other organisations who are part of the Community Share can contribute the remainder, and a suitable candidate can be found, then it looks as if a short-term hiatus has been avoided. However, a longer-term solution will need to be found and this will not be easy, given the financial situation of organisations in the town and the ever increasing call on resources.

A number of communities across the country are engaging in projects to introduce red squirrels, as opposed to their nasty cousins, the grey squirrel. Robin Ree is exploring this locally and, if it proves possible, it could become an added tourist attraction to the town.

As I wrote at length last month, Allan Muirhead has decided to retire from the Town Council. Nick Cotton also decided not to stand for the new Westmorland and Furness Council. Nick has been a Town Councillor, SLDC Councillor, CCC Councillor and a representative on the Yorkshire Dales Board. The Town Council thanked them both for their hard work on behalf of the town and wished them all the best for the future.

Eight councillors were re-elected unopposed (myself, Issy Bradshaw, Geoffrey Buswell, Paul Cassell, Mike Marczynski, Braddan Quayle, Robin Ree and Maddy Williams). We have one vacancy, apply now.

Monitor Your Local Peatland?

Over the last year, Yorkshire Dales environmental campaigning charity, Friends of the Dales have collaborated with Yorkshire Peat Partnership to recruit and train Eyes on the Bog volunteers to monitor peatland condition across various sites in the Dales. Eight small monitor teams are now in place, and so the charities are inviting those interested in volunteering for the scheme to come along to their next joint training event taking place Saturday 13 May, 10am – 3pm near Ribblehead Viaduct.

Healthy peatlands are vital to biodiversity, water purity and crucial for preventing the thousands of years of carbon stored in the form of peat being released into the atmosphere. Eyes on the Bog is a IUCN programme which offers a scientifically robust, repeatable, low tech way for individuals and small groups from villages or parishes to review the condition of their own local peatlands two or three times per year.

If following the training event, people want to commit to becoming a volunteer monitor, they will be given easy to use kit enabling them to assess vegetation quality and measure the depth and fluctuations in the water table and also variations in peat quality and depth. Their findings are then fed directly into the Peat Data Hub hosted

by the University of Leeds and are an important resource for assessing the effectiveness of restoration and how peatlands are changing through time.

Community Interest Company

On 18 July, 2011, the Kirkby Lonsdale & Lune Valley Community Interest Company was registered with Companies House as a private company, limited by guarantee, without share capital.

That's the formal bit. I was one of the two founding directors, and I have been regularly asked over the years: 'Just what is a community interest company? And what do you do?'

In a sentence, it's a special type of limited company which exists to benefit the community rather than private shareholders. Any profit, or surplus, is used to grow and develop its business so as to benefit its community, or goes directly to benefit that community. In our case, the community is Kirkby Lonsdale, its population, its businesses, its attractions.

Why did we form the company? South Lakeland District Council were running the town's Thursday Charter Market, operating the free public toilets in Jingling Lane and at Devil's Bridge, and providing tourist information from their shop at 24 Main Street.

The market was a mess. Remember when only two or three traders turned up? The toilets were old, unclean, and generally unattractive, and there was no direct income from advising tourists what to do in and around the town. SLDC wanted rid of the lot.

I had been a town councillor for about 14 years at the time, and the town council was appalled when they were told the market, the toilets and the tourist information shop faced closure. Kirkby Lonsdale is a tourist town and these basic facilities were regarded as essential to contributing to the economic prosperity of the town.

The town council negotiated with SLDC who eventually agreed to lease all three facilities to the town at pepper-corn rents. When the leases were finalised, the town council realised that it could not properly manage these services on a day-to-day basis on top of all its other responsibilities. I made numerous inquiries about how best to devolve this responsibility and a community interest company seemed most appropriate.

Working with a local business lady, Judith Manifold, she and I produced a business plan which was agreed by the town council who then contracted out the management of these three services to the new community interest company of which we were the two founding Directors.

Next month, I'll explain what happened next - how the toilets were modernised, how the market changed, and how the 'tourist' information shop became a 'visitor' information shop. And how we started to spread our wings.

Casterton WI April meeting

After the business part of the meeting was concluded, we had an illuminating talk from Kim Bradshaw, proprietor of the Zero Pantry, in which she told of her background in eco-friendly New Zealand and her subsequent environmental journey into setting up her business in Kirkby Lonsdale and now Sedbergh.

Some fascinating facts convinced her of the need to help others offset their carbon footprint e.g every plastic toothbrush ever made is still around in a landfill somewhere and will still be there in several generations to come, the water required to produce a cheap T-shirt would provide enough for a family in a third world country to survive for months, every dead marine animal found nowadays has plastic in their body and plastic has even been found in human breast milk! These all served to underpin her passion to convince others to manage their environmental impact carefully.

As a society, we have become so reliant on plastic, (only half of which is recyclable); it is easy to overlook its ubiquitous presence and she reminded us of the need to make conscious choices about what we buy.

Kim suggested many ways in which we could all play a part using the Reduce-Reuse-Recycle approach with Reduce being the key element:

*Using solid soaps and shampoo bars to reduce the plastic bottles we buy weekly *Refilling containers with produce to save duplicating packaging *Using washing/laundry pellets and then adding our own water rather than buying large bottles *Making your own cleaning products using white wine vinegar suffused with essential oils *Putting teabags into smelly trainers to reduce odours instead of using aerosols *Using dryer balls when drying clothing to reduce energy usage by 28% *Purchasing biodegradable freezer bags/sponge rolls to reduce plastic waste.

She informed us that in 2019, UK supermarkets produced 96000 tons of plastic packaging and that 50% of the plastic production in the UK is for single use. She emphasised that recycling is a very limited and costly process and therefore should be treated as a last option. We all need to do what we can to reduce waste in the first instance rather than hope the recycling system will do the job for us.

Kim ended by demonstrating some of the most popular and useful products she supplies in her shop which members were intrigued by and many planned to visit her shop on their next journey into town.

my boss has told me I'll have to work on bank holidays. This was never the case in my old job. Can my employer really make me work on a public holiday, and should I get paid extra if I do?"

Unfortunately, when it comes to bank holidays, whether or not staff have to work is up to their employer and you don't have to be paid more if you do. If you have a contract, this should set out your personal situation.

A contract might say that you will always get bank holidays off, or that you may sometimes be required to work them, or that you will always be required to work them. But if your contract says you get bank holidays off you shouldn't be asked to work.

Your contract might say something like: "In addition to bank and public holidays, your annual entitlement to holidays is X days". This means you get public holidays off in addition to your annual leave entitlement but it might not mean you're entitled to take the specific days off. You may be required to work a bank holiday, in which case you should get another day off instead.

Alternatively, it might say something like: "Your annual holiday entitlement (inclusive of bank and public holidays) is X days" - this means you have to take bank holidays off as part

"I recently started a new job where of your annual leave entitlement.

A common misunderstanding around bank holidays is that employers have to pay you extra for working them. This is not the case. Unless your contract says you'll be paid extra you will just be paid your normal amount. Your employer has to follow what's set out in your contract.


If you don't have a contract, the legal default position is that your employer can tell you when you can or can't take time off. If you'd like to request a bank holiday off, use the normal method for requesting time off.

If you find you need to resolve an issue with your employer, first ask for an informal chat, where you can raise your concerns. If this doesn't get you anywhere, you may need to raise a formal grievance. If you need advice on this, contact South Lakes Citizens Advice.
